## SECTION 2 -- HAZARDS IDENTIFICATION

**Hazard Classification:** Skin Corrosion/Irritation Category: 1C; Eye Damage/Irritation Category: 1

**Hazard Statement:** Causes severe skin burns and eye damage.

## SECTION 4 -- FIRST-AID MEASURES

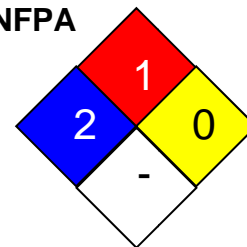
**Eye Contact:** IF IN EYES: Hold eyelids open and flush with a steady, gentle stream of water for 15-20 minutes. Get medical attention.  
**Skin Contact:** IF ON SKIN: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Remove contaminated clothing and wash clothing before reuse. Get medical attention if irritation persists.  
**Inhalation:** IF INHALED: Move to fresh air. If not breathing, call 911, then give artificial respiration, preferable mouth-to-mouth. Get medical attention.  
**Ingestion:** IF SWALLOWED: Call a doctor or get medical attention. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg white, gelatin solution, or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid Alcohol.
